- He is considered to be the father of the Toyota Production System.



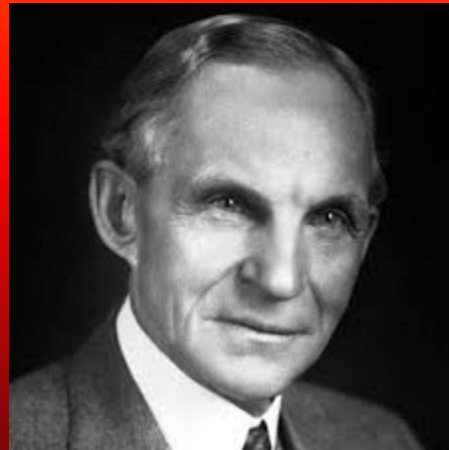
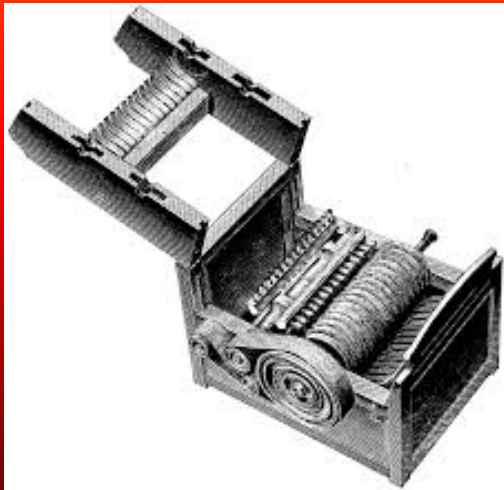
# What is lean manufacturing?
